INSTRUCTION

Kalkan town is a short taxi journey from the house. The Boat House has always been a very private property, so not all taxi drivers will be familiar with it. Explain to drivers that the house is in Kalamar Bay and is located in front of The Glass House.

HIRE CARS & DRIVING

DRIVING

- Traffic is on the right hand side, with a 50 km/h (30 mph) limit in urban areas and 90 km/h (56 mph) on main roads. Speed checkpoints are common and drivers may be fined on the spot (approx £25).

- On roundabouts, traffic gives way to the right - you may be expected to stop half way round.

- If a vehicle intends to turn left, it may indicate left but then pull over on the right to allow traffic to pass before turning.

- If an oncoming vehicle flashes you, it means it intends to keep moving, therefore you should stop (opposite to UK).

- If you pass stones on the road, it may mean there's an accident ahead.

- If you have an accident, call the police (112). Without a police report the insurance will be void. You should also contact the hire car company with a photo of the vehicle.

- The legal blood alcohol limit is 0.5%.

- You need to carry your passport and driving license with you, together with the vehicle's documentation (usually in glove compartment).





Over the water on wooden platforms are a handful of eateries. Travellers wanting to traverse the gorge can join a canyoning tour. Other activities include river rafting.


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PATARA

The Constant

Founded by the Lycians, Patara became an important city in the Roman Empire. Its surviving buildings, including temples and a monumental triumphal arch, are fascinating to explore. We recommend combining this cultural trip with a visit to the local beach.



A picturesque fishing town, approximately 20 minutes from Kalkan along the stunning Lycian Mediterranean coastal road. Great for lunch out and to see the site of ancient Antiphellos, with still-visible ruins including an amphitheatre.


From the harbour, you can board the ferry to Meis, a charming Greek Island just a short distance away.



This city is one of the most important religious focal points in Lycia. It is a sanctuary dedicated to Leto. The name Leto, the mother of Artemis and Apollo, first appears as 'Lada' in the clay tablets written in Luvi language, which dates back to the 2nd century BC. There's also the temples of Apollo and Artemis beside the sanctuary of Letoon.



THURSDAY MARKET



Kalkan has a bustling market every Thursday, which is situated off the main road leading into the town. Here you can find local produce and 'genuine fake' goods. Kalkan offers shops that cater for basic tourists needs, as well as offering unique boutiques and high quality leather shops. A great place to find 'genuine fakes', including well made watches, luggage and handbags. Traditional Turkish pottery can be found in abundance. Our favourite jewellery outlet, Yardan's, sells exclusive silver, gold and diamonds. There's also plenty of shops selling Turkish rugs & carpets.


Calling this number will enable you to make contact with the police, fire brigade or coast guard. This number covers the whole Antalya region.

CLEANING

The Boat House is professionally cleaned every Saturday. If you would like an additional mid-week clean, then please get in contact with the Property Manager - this will be an extra cost.

SMOKING

Out of courtesy for nonsmoking guests and fire safety, please do not smoke inside. Ashtrays are provided to enable you to smoke outside the property.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER

A fire extinguisher can be found in the kitchen island cupboard, located on the middle floor.

RUBBISH DISPOSAL

Please leave rubbish bags in the green dustbin by the garage. Every day someone from our team will collect this and dispose of it for you.

SAFES

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NO GLASS BY POOL

Please do not use glass or chinaware by the pool. There are unbreakable plates and cups in the downstairs kitchen, which can be used outside.



HOUSE PROTOCOLS



AIR CON & LIGHTS

The air conditioning will work more effectively if doors are closed.

Please ensure that you switch off lights and air conditioning when leaving the house. The rooms will cool down very quickly when you switch back on the air conditioning upon your return.

BREAKAGES

If any items break during your stay, or if an appliance is not working properly, please inform the Property Manager, so that it can be replaced or repaired. Please note that some breakages may be chargeable.

WET COSTUMES

Please keep wet swimming costumes away from any upholstered furniture.

SECURITY & LOCKING UP

Pease ensure all doors are locked when leaving the house. For sliding doors, the handle will need to be twisted upwards. The front door should be double locked and garages closed.

Please do not interfere with the security cameras.

Being in the Mediterranean climate, Turkey has its fair share of insects. Please ensure that doors are not left open throughout the day and do watch out for spiders and scorpions. Do not leave clothes on the floor.

TOILET ETIQUETTE

Guests are politely requested not to put excessive paper, face wipes, sanitary products etc down the loo. Please note, drain blockages that occur due to not following this advice are chargeable.

CINEMA ROOM & HOUSE AUDIO




The Boat House is equipped with Bluetooth speakers inside and outside, which can be controlled by your Smartphone. These can be linked to music streaming apps, including Spotify and Tidal. To be able to use the system, you will need to pair the Bluetooth speakers to your Smartphone and download the 'BluOS Controller' app.

There are detailed instructions that explain how to work the audio system, within the HiFi cabinet, on the middle floor. Within the Cinema Room, you will find a DVD player and a selection of DVDs that you can enjoy.

Alternatively, for a wider choice of viewing, the TV is also equipped with Apple TV. We have a Boat House Netflix account that you can use or you can login to a personal viewing app of your choice, such as Amazon Prime.

There are instructions in the Cinema Room, which explain how to work the equipment. Please remember to turn off the projector after use.



Please note, the WiFi in Kalkan is not very strong, so Apple TV & music streaming can be temperamental if used at the same time.

SAFETY

TAKE PRECAUTION

Our guest safety and wellbeing is of paramount importance. However, it should be noted that safety standards in Turkey differ to the UK. We recommend that upon arrival to the Boat House, you familiarise yourself with the layout. If you're travelling with children, please take time to point out to them areas where they should take particular care, such as the swimming pool, balconies and terraces.

Please adopt the following common-sense rules when using the swimming pool:

- Please observe our no diving policy.
- Children and non-swimmers must always be supervised.
- Do not run around the pool side or up the steps, some areas may be slippery when wet.
- Do not swim if you cannot see the bottom of the pool. If this is the case then please contact the Property Manager, Ali Ozturk. Cloudiness can be caused by heavy thunderstorms and excess sun tan oil.
- Always wear sun protection when outside in the daytime and reapply after going in the pool.
- Avoid swimming if you've been drinking alcohol, especially late at night.



KALKAN

KALKAN'S HISTORY

Kalkan is situated in the heart of the Lycian region. Formerly a Greek village called Kalamaki, Kalkan is thought to have been founded around 200 years ago by traders from the nearby Greek Island of Meis. The success of those early traders encouraged others of both Greek and Turkish origin to settle in Kalkan. Evidence of this is witnessed by the similarity of architecture between Meis and Kalkan. Settlement was further promoted by Kalkan's harbour which was the only safe, hospitable harbour between Fethiye and Kas.

Kalkan residents traded various produce, including; charcoal, silk, cotton, olive oil, timber, grapes and sesame. This produce was brought to Kalkan from the plains of Patara and loaded onto ships in the village's harbour, where goods were then exported across the Ottoman Empire.

In 1923, the new Turkish Republic and Greece embarked upon a population exchange as a result of the Turkish War of Independence. Greeks who were living in Turkey moved to Greece and Australia, and Turks who were living in Greece moved to Turkey. Most of Kalkan's Greek community migrated back to Meis.

KALKAN'S ELECTRICITY

It should be noted that Kalkan has semi-frequent power cuts; however, they are usually very brief. If such a situation arises, you will find candles and tea lights located around the Boat House that you can use.

KALKAN'S WATER SUPPLY

We recommend that you do not drink the tap water in Turkey due to its high mineral content.

The main kitchen in the Boat House offers filtered drinking water from the fridge and the small silver tap by the sink. Please note, if the 'lock' feature is enabled on the fridge, you will not be able to use it for water and ice.

Alternatively you can purchase large water containers from the village supermarkets.


